At strategic levels he served as the Director of National Intelligence Representative to a foreign allied nation; 8 years as a NSA Field Chief; Office of the Joint Chiefs of Staff with duty on the US Delegation to NATO (Brussels, Belgium) and at the Pentagon served on the Department of the Army Staff.
